Fee Schedule

Veteran Medical Records Review: US\$250/flat fee

Fee may be waived in certain cases, including all mefloquine-related cases. Please contact Dr. Nevin for a free initial telephone consultation or to discuss your fee- or case-related questions.

Veteran Nexus Letter / IMO Report Preparation: US\$1000-\$2000/flat fee

All initial mefloquine-related cases are \$1000 and addendum reports are \$500. Fees for other cases will vary based on their complexity, with any fees for initial medical records review credited towards the final cost. Please contact Dr. Nevin for a free initial telephone consultation or to discuss your fee- or case-related questions.

Other Medicolegal Consulting Services: US\$250/hour

No charge for initial attorney telephone consultation. Hourly fees cover document review and research, report writing, and all administrative tasks, and are billed in quarter-hour increments. Typical rates for concise medico-legal reports are \$2000 to \$4000. Certain cases may require a non-refundable retainer. Please contact Dr. Nevin for details.

Deposition and Expert Witness Trial Services: US\$500/hour

Billable at a minimum full-day (8 hour) for the first scheduled day, then at half-day (4 hour) increments for each subsequent half-day. A non-refundable retainer is payable at time of scheduling.

Additional Information: Unless arranged directly by the client, client shall be responsible for reasonable travel expenses to include accommodation and transportation. Alternatively, a flat rate for travel expenses may be negotiated at the time of scheduling. For criminal, legal aid, and similar publicly funded cases, fees and travel expenses may be limited to those for comparable services in published schedules subject to prior agreement. To avoid undue burden or expense, requests for records and ordered response to non-party subpoenas will be billed at \$250/hour in quarter-hour increments, plus any reasonable anticipated legal fees, and will be payable prior to production.
